

  Do you want your home to be accessible as you age?
  Wider doorways, main-floor bedrooms, no-step entries, or barrier-free showers
- Privacy Needs
  Do you need separation
  between spaces?
  Think noise levels, guest
  areas, primary suite

- Family Size & Future Growth
  Are you planning to grow
  your family, care for aging
  parents or host guests?
  Plan bedrooms, bathrooms &
  flex spaces accordingly
- Entertaining Style
  Do you host large gatherings,
  dinners or outdoor events?
  Consider open layouts, larger
  kitchens, fire pit areas &
  guest bathrooms
- Outdoor Living
  How important is your yard and the connection to the outdoors?
  Think about decks, patios, gardens, fire pits, or even views you want to see
- Are lower utility bills or green living a priority?

  Look into high-efficiency HVAC, insulation, triple pane windows, solar readiness

  Do you need a home gym,
